Rules:

- * Talks will be on you and your work at TRIUMF. Try your best to convey to the audience why your work is important to TRIUMF and/or to the greater physics community.
- * Talks will be no longer than 3 minutes a buzzer will go off to indicate the end of the talk, and speakers will be cut short.
- * Talks will have at most ONE slide the slide must be submitted to the Committee of the Society of Graduate Students and Postdocs (sgspdcommittee@trmail.triumf.ca) at least 24 hours prior to the Jamboree.
- * Talks will be judged by a panel of experts, and on three main categories: Conveyance, Engagement and Style.

How to participate:

Sign up on the Doodle poll (see the email) indicating your interest. If you are one of the first 15 to sign up, we will notify you that you are in! After that, you will need to come up with a 3 minute talk on your own about you and your work at TRIUMF. At least 24 hours prior to the Jamboree, you will need to submit your slide to the organizing committee (see above). On the day of the Jamboree, we will have an ordered list of the participants. Participants will be called to come to the front of the auditorium to give their talk, and the subsequent participant will be notified that they are next (so that they can get ready).

After all the talks are finished, we will tabulate the results and send an email out to the Society of Graduate Students and Posdocs (of which you are a member!) regarding who the winner was.
