

Presentations Skills Training Day

The Presentation Skills training day, facilitated by the Centre for Teaching, Learning and Technology (CTLT) is designed to strengthen presenters' skills through intensive, yet practical exercises in giving presentations. The workshop is designed for participants who expect to participate in research project presentation competitions, present their research at conferences or within their academic or organizational departments; participants might also consider taking this workshop if they are preparing to defend a thesis or dissertation. Participants in this workshop work closely with peers and trained facilitators to begin to develop their presentation skills, to enhance existing skills, and/or to try new and challenging ideas. The workshop consists of planning and organizing a presentation and various topical sessions, including, for example, asking and answering questions.

Workshop activities will engage participants in:

- working closely with peers to improve presentation skills
- practicing presentation strategies and techniques
- recognizing the importance of knowing your audience
- developing presentations around a well-defined purpose
